We are happy to share this Newsletter, “**Gratefully Yours - 3**” acknowledging the generous contribution of the donors. It is with immense gratitude we present this thanking the donors for their overwhelming support and response. We are happy to give you an insight into the Chinmaya Education Movement which started in 1965, when Pujya Gurudev Swami Chinmayananda established the first School at Kollengode, Kerala. In Gurudev's own words, in the letter written for the inauguration of Chinmaya Vidyalaya, Kollengode in 1965 “Children are the very cream of our generation and they are the rulers and makers of tomorrow. Upon them depends the future of our nation and the safety of our culture and tradition. Let us give them a healthy physical and mental atmosphere to grow, ingrain in them respect for life, love for living creatures, team spirit, national fervor and pride in our Indian culture. I am sure that such schools will grow everywhere throughout the country under the benign patronage and service of our Mission branches.”

### **The Chinmaya Vision Program- the USP of our Education Movement**

Chinmaya Vidyalayas are called SWAD schools, Schools with A Difference. The differentiating element is the Chinmaya Vision Program. The emphasis of the program is to provide individuals with the right vision of life. “As the vision, so the creation”. Chinmaya Vision Program is a Value Based Education Program. It reflects the ethos of the National Education Policy 2020 and it is so amazing that the various aspects of NEP 2020 have been a part of the Chinmaya Vidyalaya Education program since 1996. CVP identifies the inculcation of values and character formation as the ultimate purpose of education. Accordingly, it focuses on child development on seven aspects, viz., physical development, mental development, intellectual development, spiritual development, awareness to Indian Culture, feeling of Patriotism and the spirit of oneness through Universal Outlook.



Such emphasis in education leads to holistic development of children. Here, the best of modern education is given in the exalted, sacred spirit of the 'Gurukula' tradition. This will create Indians who will fit perfectly into and contribute much to today's society. At the same time, they will remain firmly entrenched in the changeless roots of our perennial philosophy. With Gurudev's 'Vision Of Education', the Chinmaya Vision Program aims to lead all those involved in education from where they stand today to reach and revel in his 'vision of life' – a vision that helps children to evolve into men and women of outstanding and lasting character and achievement. Schools that are not part of Chinmaya Mission are also encouraged to implement the Chinmaya Vision program by becoming 'Vision Schools'. The Chinmaya Vidyalayas have been making a great impact in the society, socially, culturally & scholastically.



## Social Impact



Chinmaya Vidyalayas cater to a cross section of the community. Some schools cater to the lower income group, and some others the middle-income group and a few for the upper middle class as well. 3 Harihara Chinmaya Vidyalayas are completely free schools run in villages for educational upliftment and skill development of the local people. Gurudev aspired that our children should emerge with non- compromising values and have the mental sagacity to serve the Nation. There is a focus on service in our vidyalayas.

- The Bal Sevak award initiative introduced in our Vidyalayas, aims at nurturing Children to have the “Seva Bhav” in them. Around 2000 students have received the Bal Sevak award for contributing 120 hours of service. Thus 2,40,000-man hours of service has been provided by our Vidyalaya Students.
- Students work very closely with the Chinmaya organization for Rural development (CORD) and with their collaboration take up various service activities.

## Scholastic Impact:


Chinmaya Vidyalayas are encouraged to offer inquiry-based learning in the classrooms. Students are exposed to a lot of varied activities and strategies to ensure holistic learning happens. Debates, puzzles, quizzes form an integral part of the teaching learning process. More than 75% of the Chinmaya Vidyalayas achieve 100 % pass in the Board Examinations.

- The Chinmaya International School was ranked as number one school in the 2018 CBSE class 12 Board examination. The Chinmaya Vidyalaya Virugambakkam & Taylors Road stand among the top 10 schools of India. As per the survey conducted by The Education World magazine, Chinmaya International residential school has been continuously ranked as no 1 in Tamil Nadu for the last 8 years and is among the top 5 schools since 2016.
- Number of Chinmaya Vidyalayas have been placed among the top 10 schools in their respective states.

## Scholarships for the needy- A Noble initiative

One of the major contributions of the Chinmaya Education Cell is to ensure all Children receive Education. Every year starting from 2014, around 100 students are identified from the Vidyalayas and they are extended support financially to meet the cost of their School fees, uniforms, books and note books. Around 20-25 lakhs is budgeted annually for the same. From 2020 due to Pandemic and thanks to our generous donors, we have extended almost 244 scholarships to different children across different Chinmaya Schools. The scholarship amounts are sent to the Schools and the same is distributed to the parents.
